LAW

Khon Kaen University (KKU) was one of four regional universities established in 1964 as part of a decentralized development plan for higher education in Thailand. The main campus is located in the Northwestern sector of Khon Kaen, just a few kilometers from the center of the city. Nong Khai Campus is located in the Northernmost of the Northeastern of Thailand, neighboring with the Laotian capital Vientiane which only 25 kilometers away.

The Department of Law of The Faculty of Integrated Social Sciences (FISS) at Thailand's renowned Khon Kaen University (Nongkhai Campus) is pleased to announce the opening of its Masters of Law (LL.M) Degree for International Students, Research Track.

Students with Bachelor of Laws Degree and good command of English are encouraged to apply to conduct research with members of our faculty, composed of Thai, GMS and U.S. Professors (Chinese Also Spoken) and to obtain an LL.M degree by research within two years of matriculation.

Students can pursue the LL.M. Degree by Research while in residence at Khon Kaen University (main or Nongkhai campus) or while spending periodic time working on their research in their home countries. On-site guidance and collaboration with faculty research advisors required;

the minimum of two weeks (80 contact hours) per semester, assuming adequate progress in research. Supplemental coordination and guidance provided through E-Conferences.

Full and partial scholarships are available for promising research students, especially students interested in conducting research related to public international law or administrative law and regulation. Research regarding law and legal issues in China (Yunnan and Zhuang Autonomous Region of Guangxi) and mainland Southeast Asia (Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand and Vietnam) is strongly encouraged.
